Penn State Lehigh Valley provides a Penn State University education in a small campus setting that integrates individualized teaching, research, and dynamic community outreach. Penn State Lehigh Valley is the oldest continuously operating campus outside of University Park. The campus has a rich history of more than 100 years.

Penn State Lehigh Valley opened its doors as one of the first permanent technical centers of The Pennsylvania State University in 1912. Today, the campus mission still emphasizes Penn State's original land-grant institution mission of advancing the economic, social, and intellectual welfare of the region.

In 2009, spurred by the continued growth of the campus, Penn State Lehigh Valley began writing a new chapter in its history by relocating and expanding to a three-story facility located in Center Valley. This setting provides expanded space and opportunities to foster the success of current and future students.

Both traditional students and adult learners can choose from many options including bachelor's and associate's degree programs, as well as access to 275 majors offered by other Penn State campuses. Penn State Lehigh Valley provides the following four-year bachelor's degrees: Arts Administration, Biobehavioral Health, Business, Corporate Communication, Health Policy and Administration, Information Sciences and Technology, Project and Supply Chain Management, Psychology, and Rehabilitation and Human Services. In addition, the campus' diverse Continuing Education and Outreach programs provide opportunities for professional development, business training, and youth programming.

Penn State Lehigh Valley offers students the value of a major university, from cutting-edge science and engineering labs where students conduct undergraduate research to art and music spaces that let creativity soar; from world-class faculty mentors to worldwide travel opportunities; and a myriad of student activities and athletic teams.
